Travelling to and from ports

We recommend that you check different options yourself, because there are many ways to travel today. These tips are only some of the possible ways to travel to and from the ports.

Belfast

The city has two airports:

Belfast City Airport (BHD), a short distance from the center: www.belfastcityairport.com.

To get to and from this airport, check: www.belfastcityairport.com

Belfast International Airport (BFS) www.belfastairport.com is 40 minutes from the city-centre. The 300 bus service, runs from the terminal to the city center every 15 minutes daily, less frequent in the evening and week-ends. (Look at www.translink.co.uk for departures Saturday and Sunday).

You can also fly to Dublin and take the train or express-bus from here. The train and bus takes approximately 2 hours and has several departures every day.

Ålesund

Ålesund Airport Vigra is about 15-20 minutes from the city center. Website: www.avinor.no/flyplass/alesund. You can take the shuttle bus to and from Ålesund, it takes approximately 25 minutes. Route information can be found here: www.177mr.no. On the same website, you find information about express-bus from Oslo as well.

Kristiansand

Kristiansand Airport Kjevik: www.avinor.no/flyplass/Kristiansand is located 16 km northeast of the center of Kristiansand. It takes approximately 20 minutes by car. The bus correspond to both domestic and international departures: www.hagakrs.no

The taxi is right outside the terminal, there are two taxi companies: Taxi South - telephone 38 02 80 00 and Agder Taxi - telephone 38 00 20 00

Another possibility is to take the train from Oslo or Stavanger: There are also express- buses going to Kristiansand. Train: www.nsb.no. Bus: www.nor-way.no or www.nettbuss.no

Aalborg

Aalborg City Airport is 6 km from the city center. For more information on departure and arrival: www.aal.dk. There are daily flights from Copenhagen.

Rostock / Warnemünde:

Bremerhaven

You can fly to Bremen international airport, from here you can take tram line 6 to the Central Station and then take the train from here to Bremerhaven, it takes about 45 minutes. Check: www.airport-bremen.de/en/nc/

IJmuiden, Amsterdam
