By Air:

There is easy access from/to the following international airports:

By Train:

Fredrikstad is only a short train ride from Oslo (1 hour 10 minutes), with hourly departures. From Gothenburg in Sweden, the train ride is 2 hours 45 minutes. The train station is a short walk from the city center, or to the free ferry over to the fortified town. Plan your travel at <https://www.vy.no/>

By Road:

Take the E6 southbound from Oslo and from Råde, you follow the signs to Fredrikstad on highway 110. If you drive from the South or West parts of Norway, it might be easier to take the ferry from Horten to Moss, rather than drive through the Oslo area. E6 from Oslo takes approximately 1 hour, E6 from Gothenburg takes approximately 2 hours.
